SCHOOL NEWS!

The Rosholt School District continues to grow with new students coming in yearly from open enrollments. At this time we have accepted five new students bringing that number up to nearly 100 of our 241 students as open enrolled students. Overall, enrollment is up by 10 students from last year.

Several years ago our high school went one-to-one with computers. Students are assigned a laptop computer as a freshman and will use that computer until they graduate. It has been a very successful program. We have also implemented a modified one-to-one program with the 7th and 8th grade students. They are each assigned a computer to use at the beginning of the year and those computers are on cart.

It has been a good way to initiate responsible computer use. Our technology needs are always an issue and it seems the elementary is put on the back burner. We would like to have two complete carts of iPads for the elementary as well as Chrome Books for the 4th and 5th grade classrooms. As of now, we have only one cart of iPads and no Chrome Books. Thank you to all who have supported our District through the Rosholt Alumni Foundation. Your continued support is very much appreciated.
